A former Union General, the first train robber, socialist, poets, writers, musicians, 1930s era gangsters, world champion athletes, and the assassin who killed Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr all came through the gates of MSP as convicts. Some left for successful careers in the arts, sports and even state government; others chose a life of more crime.

Missouri State Penitentiary has a long, colorful history and has existed through many changes; from the Mass Prison Era which had harsh punishments and isolated living in cold cells to the more modern work release programs with intensive supervision. On this tour you will learn about the life of a prisoner, the successful and unsuccessful escapes, riots, punishments, executions and famous inmates. This is a "Hard Hat" tour with lots of walking; comfortable shoes are a must.

After this extreme tour we will be ready for a hardy lunch at Prison Brews.

A guided tour of the MO Supreme Court will give us an inside view of our court system at work. This building was built with the money earned from the 1904 World's Fair.
